Educational goals & characteristics

This is a shared position between the Children's Hospital at Westmead and Sydney Children's Hospital. Clinics involve Orthopaedic and Rehabilitation Departments as well as supervised surgical lists of both hospitals.

The fellow, with increasing autonomy, will provide optimal care and develop clinical proficiency in the care of paediatric patients with complex health problems. This will involve advanced knowledge in theory, clinical skills, surgery, teaching and research related to orthopaedics.

The fellow will participate in Botulinum toxin clinics and will have access to gait laboratory results, including gait-related research and gait reporting.
