The fellow will be part of an established Limb Reconstruction Service, comprising two surgeons, specialist nurse and specialist physiotherapist. Training will be provided in the following ways:

- 1 Analysis of deformity - clinical, radiological and gait laboratory
- 2 Clinicopathological tutorials and journal review
- 3 Preoperative planning sessions
- 4 Operative surgical experience as assistant and supervised surgeon according to expertise (please note that this is subject to qualification recognition by the Medical Practitioners Board of Victoria)
- 5 Postoperative review with physiotherapist, clinical nurse specialist and supervising surgeon
- 6 Workshops for the study of cross-sectional anatomy and application of external fixation
- 7 Exposure to ancillary surgery related to limb reconstruction.
