	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• FRACS or equivalent international qualifications.• Certified copies of undergraduate and postgraduate degrees.• Current CV.• Two written references from senior orthopaedic surgeons with whom you have worked with in the last 2 years.• All candidates must be competent in speaking, writing and understanding the English language. International applicants will need to provide IELTS results as proof of English proficiency, with a score of at least 7 in every unit in one sitting.

The process for obtaining Australian medical registration and an appropriate visa is lengthy.
