<b>Requirements/ criteria</b>	<p>The Prospective Fellow is a medical graduate who has completed FRACS or an equivalent approved Orthopaedic surgery training program. Full registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency is mandatory.</p> <p>The applicant must have a strong interest in hip surgery, and a desire to become proficient in both hip joint preservation surgery (osteotomy and arthroscopy) and arthroplasty, as well as an established record in undertaking research.</p>	

	<p>Overseas candidates must comply with requirements to enter Australia on an occupational training visa. AHPRA English proficiency test must have two-year validity from intended start date.</p>
