Educational goals and characteristics	<p>The goal of the fellowship is to teach the fellow the surgical practice of shoulder surgery including both arthroscopy and arthroplasty. They are expected to submit a research paper for publication during the fellowship.</p> <p>The fellow will become competent in primary shoulder arthroplasty (reverse and anatomical) and will have exposure to revision arthroplasty cases. By the completion of their fellowship they will become competent in arthroscopic instability surgery and be able to perform arthroscopic rotator cuff repairs, depending on the fellow they will have performed arthroscopic latarjet procedures.</p> <p>The fellow will be expected to be competent in trauma surgery and will be exposed to dealing with complex revision shoulder cases.</p>	
Requirements/ criteria	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The applicant must have completed orthopaedic training in a recognised training scheme and have a desire to continue practicing in shoulder surgery in their subsequent professional life. • Applicants must have a demonstrated interest in research. • Excellent English is necessary.
