

Third-Party Authenticator Apps: Register an App

- 1. Install a third-party authenticator on your mobile device. Apps are available from the Apple App Store or Google Play.
- 2. On your computer, log in to your account. You may be prompted to verify your identity with a one-time passcode via email or text message.
- 3. Select Use verification codes from an authenticator app.
- 4. The Connect an Authenticator app screen displays.








Third-Party Authenticator Apps: Register an App continued

- 5. On your mobile device, open your authenticator app and select to add a new account.
- Use the authenticator app to scan the QR barcode that's displayed on your computer.
- 7. The authenticator app is connected to your account. The app automatically starts generating time-based one-time passcodes.
- 8. On your computer, enter a code generated by the authenticator app in the Verification Code field, then click Connect.









Third-Party Authenticator Apps: Logging In

- On the login screen, enter your username and password, as usual.
- You're prompted to enter a code from your authenticator app to verify your identity.
- 3. On your mobile device, open your authenticator app to get a time-based one-time passcode.
- On your computer, enter the code generated by the authenticator app, then click Verify. You're successfully logged in to your account.
