

## Information about hosting The Travelling Exhibition of Orthopaedics in Australia

The specialty of orthopaedics keeps our children 'in the game'; it puts a 'bounce' back into the hips and knees of the elderly; it 'keeps us moving'.

The Travelling Exhibition of Orthopaedics in Australia celebrates the contribution of orthopaedics to the health and well-being of the Australian community.

The Exhibition charts the development of orthopaedics in Australia by focusing on some 'high interest' areas of orthopaedics, for the purpose of raising community awareness.

The exhibition comprises 50 pull-up banners, on topics such as:

- Orthopaedics in War Time
- Joint Replacement Hip & Knee
- Bones and Fractures
- AOA's NJRR and its role in ensuring the best for the Australian community
- Orthopaedic Outreach
- Training Expert Orthopaedic Surgeons in Australia
- Key advances in orthopaedic surgery through the years – from Charnley's Hip to 3D printed prostheses and robotics

Display items include a 90 second video about 'The Wonder of Movement', prosthetic models, surgical tools, x-rays and fixation devices.

## HOSTING THE EXHIBITION

The Exhibition is portable and modular; it can adapt and 'fit in' to whatever display space is available. You may wish to exhibit some or all of the display items. Potential locations for its display include a foyer, hallway, waiting area or corridor.

In addition to the space required for the banners, it requires 4 trestle tables and a TV/screen for showing of the video, which will play on a loop.
